Resolution:	<p>Whereas: Changes in the definition of Range Qualification require corresponding changes to the WIWL Range Rules and Standard Operating Procedures previously approved as of 1/1/2019, of which the first three full paragraphs read (with proposed changes marked):</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Effective as of January-February 61, 2020 202019</p> <p>By using a Chapter range, you<u>Members</u> are explicitly indicating that you<u>they</u> have read and understand these rules and procedures and have agreed to follow them. <u>You-Members</u> will be held responsible and accountable for your actions. Failure to follow any posted rule or procedure may result in a member's loss of range privileges, expulsion from the Chapter, prosecution, or civil lawsuit.</p> <p>Use of Winchester Chapter ranges is limited to Winchester Chapter m<u>WIWL Members in good standing who have met the Range Qualification requirements set from time to time by the Range Committee and approved by the Chapter Board of Directors as indicated by an RQ sticker on their membership ID cards, their registered and</u> guests, and to others specifically authorized by the Chapter Board of Directors.</p> <p>Range Guest Policy</p> <p>WIWL Members in Good Standing who are Range Qualified (members who have completed Chapter Orientation and yearly requalification) may bring up to two guests at a time to shoot on the WIWL ranges. The host member must sign their guest in at the Chapter House and is responsible for his/her guests while they are on the range, must supervise their shooting, and so may not shoot while their guests are shooting. The host member is responsible for ensuring that each guest complies with posted range policies and procedures.
